IMPOSITION OF LEVY FOR HARVESTING OF MARINE RESOURCES: MARINE RESOURCES ACT, 2000

Under section 44(4) of the Marine Resources Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000), after consultation with the Marine Resource Advisory Council and with the approval of the Minister of Finance, I, with effect from 01 April 2014 -

- (a) impose a levy for the benefit of the Fisheries Observer Fund in respect of the harvesting of marine resources as set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) repeal Government Notice No. 139 of 31 May 2013.

SCHEDULE

1. A person who engages in harvesting in Namibian waters in terms of a right, an exploratory right or fisheries agreement must pay a levy at a rate of 0.9% of landed value of each fishery and per species.
2. The person referred to in paragraph 1 must pay the levy referred to in that paragraph -
 - (a) to the Fisheries Observer Fund: P.O. Box 2903, Walvis Bay; and

- (b) within 7 days of receipt of the invoice from the Fisheries Observer Fund.
3. The Minister may impose interest at the rate of 12% against any person who fails to pay the levy due and payable.
